BUILDING PERMIT REMINDER

Before performing any construction, repairs, addition and major replacement of a water heater, heating and air systems, or performing any electrical work, please check with the Town of Bolivar in order to receive the proper permit and inspections for work being performed. There are many important reasons to obtain the required permit(s) and to obtain the inspections reauired for vour construction project. Your home or business is an investment. If your construction does not comply with the codes that have been adopted by the State of West Virginia and the Town of Bolivar, the value of your investment could be reduced. Property insurers may not cover work or damages that is caused by work performed without permits and inspections. When property is sold, the owner is required to disclose any improvements or repairs made, and proof of proper permits being obtained. Your permit allows code officials to reduce hazards of potential unsafe construction. in order to ensure compliance to state mandated energy codes, to provide for public health and safety and welfare. By following code guidelines, your completed project will meet minimum standards of safety and will be less likely to cause injury to you, your family, your friends, or future owners. Mandatory Inspections act as a system of checks and balances resulting in a safer project. We are here to assist you or answer any questions you may have for your project.
